Guest Speaker: Noah Mickey-Colman (Curriculum Technology Integrator)

- Who is our CTI?
 - Noah has been teaching for 13 years. Started in ELA and math and has been at CFSD for 4 years now. He splits his time between Manzanita and Ventana Vista.
- What does our CTI do at school?
 - Teaches lessons, independently and with teachers
 - Internet safety and digital citizenship
 - Connecting classes with technology professionals
 - Works with teachers to integrate new technology into lessons
 - Professional development for teachers
 - Selects new software for grade levels and school
 - Helps families with Parent/Student Vue, Bloomz, technology questions.
- Examples of lessons
 - 5th Grade Podcasts (created in Imovie)
 - Ms. Inglee's forced perspective (used with I pads)
 - Surgical Robots at Ventana Vista
 - Robotics at Manzanita
 - Skype with published authors
- Internet Safety with K-5 classes
 - Developmentally appropriate instruction for K-5 (Kindergarten: ask permission before using technology to 5th grade: cyberbullying)
 - Digital Citizenship

- Cyberbullying
- Respecting other's work on the internet (Plagiarism)
- Resources: Common Sense Media, Netsmartz
- Recommendations for Adults:
 - Know COPPA
 - Federal act "Children's Online Privacy Protection Act)
 - Companies have to ask adult permission to make an account for under age 13
 - Set up accounts for your kids
 - Access to passwords and shared information (age, photos)
 - Goal is to protect their privacy
 - Always be in the room with your child and the device
 - No devices in bedrooms
 - Screen time limits
 - Elementary schools: 1 hour or less
 - Access to accounts including school email
 - Email and password can be found on ParentVue
 - School email is only used for school related emails, teachers can only respond to the student through the school email
 - Set parental settings on apps and websites
 - Stay informed!
